**Report on Compliance with the
provision of statistical data in
accordance with Statistical Rules
Coffee years 2022/23 to
2023/2024**

Background

1. This document provides information on the compliance of Members with the Rules on Statistics approved by the Council, which are contained in documents [ICC-102-9 Rev. 5](#) – Certificates of Origin and [ICC-102-10](#) – Statistical Reports.
2. The information contained herein covers data received from 1 October 2022 up to 1 August 2024. It should be noted that the report now includes all of the data required under the Rules on Statistics. For Exporting Members, this comprises data on preliminary exports, exports, Certificates of Origin, imports, price paid to growers, retail prices, opening stocks, production, consumption, area under coffee and crop distribution. For Importing Members, the included reports are on imports, re-exports, retail prices, roastings and inventories.
3. Compliance by Members with respect to the provision of timely statistics for all data required is summarized in Table 1 for Exporting Members and Table 2 for Importing Members.

Action

The Joint Committee is requested to consider the Report on Compliance and, if deemed necessary, to make recommendations to the Council.

REPORT ON COMPLIANCE WITH STATISTICAL RULES

1. The indicator framework set out in document [SC-87/18](#) considers both timeliness and completion to calculate an annual score for each Member as well as total scores/averages for each category. A score of 0 indicates that none of the required reports were submitted in the aforementioned period. Conversely, a score of 100 indicates that all reports were submitted within the time limits prescribed in the Rules on Statistics.
2. These compliance indicators succinctly summarize the completeness and timeliness of the information provided to the Statistics Section as required by the Rules on Statistics. Overall, the indicators show that there are a number of reports that are not frequently provided by Members. The Statistics Section uses supplementary, but still official, trade statistics or estimates in compliance with [SC-78/17](#) - Statistics Committee Report as approved by the Council under item 105 ([ICC 120/16](#)).
3. Members encountering difficulties in implementing the Rules on Statistics and providing timely and accurate data are encouraged to contact the ICO Statistics Section for support and training.
4. Members are also encouraged to integrate the statistical database of Certifying Agencies through a REST API, thereby enabling the automatic transmission of data.
