**Basis for the distribution of votes
among exporting Members
for coffee year 2007/08**

1. The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to remind Members that, under the provisions of paragraph (5) of Article 13 of the International Coffee Agreement 2001, the distribution of votes is determined by the Council at the beginning of each coffee year.
2. In order to permit the Council to take a decision on the distribution of votes among exporting Members for coffee year 2007/08 it is necessary, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of Article 13, to establish the average volume of their exports of coffee to all destinations in the preceding four calendar years, that is from 2003 to 2006. The attached table has been prepared as far as possible on the basis of information received from exporting Members up to 26 September 2007.
3. If no objections are made by the exporting Members concerned, the figures contained in the attached table will be used as the basis for the determination of the votes of exporting Members in coffee year 2007/08.
4. Information on the basis for the distribution of votes among importing Members for coffee year 2007/08 is contained in document ED-2018/07 Rev. 1.
